LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Identify and differentiate: Leaves with parallel and reticulate venation, plants with taproot and fibrous roots, plants having monocot seeds and dicot seeds, terrestrial and aquatic animals, components of food, magnetic, and non-magnetic materials, different types of motions, hard and soft materials, soluble and insoluble materials, transparent, translucent and opaque materials, mass and volume, Celsius, Fahrenheit and Kelvin scale..
